The National Commission for women proposes to empanel practicing lawyers to assist the Commission in the complaints cases received by it and advise the Commission on the course of action to be adopted in the case. The lawyers empanelled would also be required to assist the Members during the hearings of the case. A sum of Rs. 350/- shall be paid as fees per sitting on each case. The lawyers empanelled may also be required to attend the important hearings at short notice and the Commission may also take their assistance during the field investigations undertaken by under the National Commission for Women Act, 1990 in various parts of the Country. They will be required to attend the field investigation, prepare reports as and when necessary.

In cases where specific legal advise is sought including preparation of any application/petition, preparation of para-wise comments to any petition filed in a court of law, the payments shall be regulated as per Ministry of Law and Justice circular F.No. 24/(2)/99-Judl. Dated 25.9.1999.
